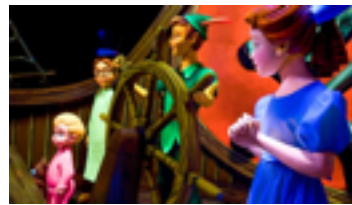

Relax and explore your resort, including one of three pools.

Enjoy a quick service dinner at the **Everything Pop Shopping and Dining** location. (1-QS)

MONDAY POLYNESIAN RESORT/ MAGIC KINGDOM

Park Hours: 9am-11pm

TRANSPORTATION

Take a bus to the Magic Kingdom and then take the Monorail or a boat to The Polynesian.

After breakfast at The Polynesian take either the Monorail or a boat to the Magic Kingdom.

Take a bus from the Magic Kingdom back to your resort.

Monday June 16

If you choose to drive, park at the Magic Kingdom using the preferred parking spaces that are available with your AAA Magic Moments package. Then take the Monorail or boat to The Polynesian.
(subject to availability; voucher with Guest name required; block-out dates apply; nontransferable and void if sold).

In this customized itinerary you will find a map with directions (done in Google Maps) from your resort to The Magic Kingdom.

ATTRACTIONS

There are six lands in the Magic Kingdom. Since you will be spending 3 days at the Magic Kingdom we will take our time and explore 3 lands each day using day 3 to revisit favorites. This will allow for a leisurely day where no one will feel rushed and you can enjoy the park.

Since breakfast is at the Polynesian you probably won't get to the Magic Kingdom until around 10:30am or so. On your first day think about focusing on Tomorrowland, Fantasyland and the New Fantasyland.

Head down Main Street USA and take in all the amazing sites of the entrance area. You have several character meet and greet opportunities.

Monday June 16

Enjoy the magic that is seeing Cinderella's Castle for the first time at the end of Main Street USA,

Make your way down Main Street USA and walk through Cinderella's Castle veer right and start your Magical day in Fantasyland.

Two of the most popular rides with wait times of up to 2 hours are Peter Pan's Flight and Winnie the Pooh. Try to get your Fast Passes for these two attractions as soon as possible.

Monday June 16

By ending your day in Tomorrowland you are close to the parade route and fireworks if you choose to stay and watch them.

ATTRACTIONS

Yesterday you focused on Fantasyland, New Fantasyland and Tomorrowland. Today take your time and explore the west side of Magic Kingdom, Liberty Square, Frontierland and Adventureland.

Head down Main Street USA and see some of the the things you may have missed yesterday. Meet some characters you may have missed yesterday and have fun!

When you get to the hub at the end of Main Street USA take the second "spoke", veer left and start your Magical day in Liberty Square.

10 THINGS TO KNOW

1 GRAB A GUIDE

Pick up an official Guide map and Times Guide as you enter any of the Theme Parks. For a complete listing of all the attractions, updated show times and approximate wait times, stop by the Tips Board.

2 DISNEY'S FASTPASS

Wanna save time waiting in line? Look for the FASTPASS kiosk at popular attractions and use your Park pass to receive an assigned return time. This allows your family to spend more time enjoying the Parks and less time standing in line. With your Magic Bands you can pre-plan up to 3 FastPasses per day, per park before you even arrive.

3 RIDE SWITCH

Have a little one in your party who's not ready to ride an attraction? As a Cast Member about "Rider Switch." One parent can wait with the child while the other rides, then switch at the end with little or no additional waiting in line.

4 DISNEY'S PHOTOPASS

It's the perfect way to make sure you capture all your magical memories- and get everyone in the picture. Photographers are ready to capture the magic for you! Get your PhotoPass card from any photographer early in your visit. Load it up with photos and then view them online.

5 DO I TIP?

Most Disney Cast Members are not allowed to accept tips. However, there are exceptions. If you use bell services to deliver luggage, \$1 per bag is customary. Tips are not included in your dining plan, so plan on tipping your wait staff in the table service restaurants.

6 SPECIAL OCCASIONS

Don't be afraid to inform cast members of a special occasion; birthday, anniversary or anything. Though the red carpet may not be rolled out, sometimes free desserts, visits from characters or extra gifts are given. This is great for a child who is in awe of the Disney experience.

7 JUST IN CASE

Disney World is a very big place and there are lots of things to distract little ones. To help cast members locate a lost child take a photo of your child before you leave for the parks. Also, putting your name and cell phone number somewhere on the child is a good idea.

8 ORLANDO WEATHER

You may encounter cooler temperatures at night during the winter and fall. Plan to bring a light weight jacket. Also, it does rain frequently for short bouts of time. It is a good idea to either bring ponchos or buy them once you get there. They are also great for covering a stroller while you are in an attraction. Wet butts are no fun!

9 STROLLERS AT THE PARKS

Make your stroller stand out. Stroller parking areas are all over the theme parks and all of the strollers look the same. Also, Cast Members often move strollers while you are in an attraction making them hard to find. To make yours stand out, put something on the handle that you can easily spot.
